



Garth Fagan Dance is monitoring governmental health authorities for the latest guidelines on how to respond to the COVID-19 virus—that is spreading across the world. Garth Fagan Dance in concert with the Ebony Repertory Theater has postponed its performances at the Nate Holden Performing Arts center in Los Angeles till April 24 -26. At the moment, we have not postponed our engagement at The EGG in Albany on March 27. As the continuing situation affects our touring and programs, Garth Fagan Dance will post any changes to our performances and school schedules on our website and social media as it becomes available. The Safety of our patrons, students and employees is our primary concern. If you are not feeling well and are scheduled to attend a Garth Fagan Dance event or class, please stay home.

What are we doing?

- At our home at 50 Chestnut Street, door handles, lockers, bathroom and other surfaces are cleaned with a hospital-grade disinfectant throughout the day
- Dispensers of hand sanitizer are available in public areas on our floor

What can you do?

- Don't panic. Be prepared and stay informed, but please continue your normal daily activities if you can
- Wash your hands regularly with soap and warm water for at least 20 seconds, particularly before and after taking a dance class
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, or mouth with unwashed hands
- Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or your sleeve (not your hands) when coughing or sneezing
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick
- Stay home if you are unwell or in an identified at-risk group (people age 70+ or with a weakened immune system)

Will we cancel activities?

- At this time, we currently have no plans to cancel our classes. Should Schools close, we will suspend our classes to follow State mandates and guidelines.
